British Columbia and the Northwest part of the United States is a vast and amazing Rocky Mountain paradise. Visitors are moved by the sheer enormity of the towering mountains, dense forests, and uncountable kilometers of crenulated coastline. It's often the smaller details that make a trip here magical. From Zen-calm ferries sliding across glassy inlets to quirky island communities, where fresh-caught seafood beats five-star restaurants. Your group will have the opportunity to explore these areas and partake in some of the excitement and educational opportunities they provide.

Day 1 • Head to Seattle

Head to Seattle. The history of Seattle as a city is itself only about 130 years long, but in that time it's become the cultural and economic center of the Pacific Northwest.

Day 2 • Explore and Serve Seattle

Explore the famous Seattle Space Needle. Later in the afternoon the group will volunteer at the Salvation Army to assist the area's homeless. Take a night tour of downtown and enjoy coffee shops, music, and festivals.

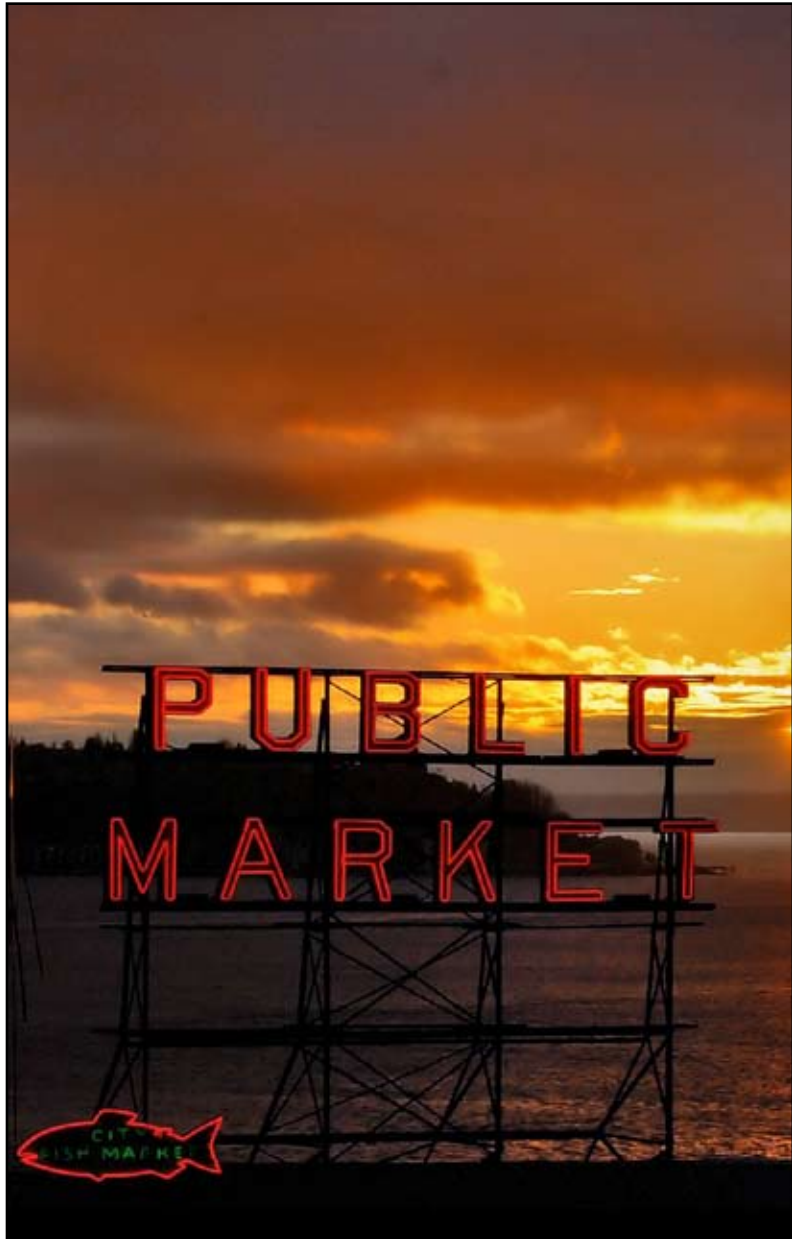
Day 3 • Pikes Market and the Seattle Aquarium

After breakfast you will head to the famous Seattle Aquarium. Later the group will head to the famous fish market in Seattle called Pikes Market. After enjoying a great dinner over looking the bay, you will have a time of reflection and may tour the Jazz section of downtown Seattle.

Day 4 • San Juan Islands and Kayaking with Orcas - Today, paddle along the scenic “West Side” of San Juan Island and view wild Orcas. Enjoy the beauty of the storm-sculpted evergreens and rocky balds covered in grasses and wildflowers. Dense kelp forests sway in the currents and the steep cliff shores are sprinkled with purple sea stars and barnacles.

Day 5 • Olympic Mountains and Rainforest - Drenched in over 12 feet of rain a year, Olympic’s west side valleys flourish with North America’s best remaining examples of temperate rain forest. Your group will hike these mountains and view amazing waterfalls.

Day 6 • Ferry to Victoria British Columbia
Take a ferry from Port Angeles to the Canadian city of Victoria. After arriving in Victoria visit museums, shops, and the world famous Butchart Gardens.

Day 7 • Salmon Fishing in British Columbia - After breakfast, enjoy some of the most spectacular fishing on Canada’s West Coast. From Sooke to Oak Bay, twenty miles in either direction, the salmon are always plentiful.

Day 8 • Tree Top Adventures
Enjoy this tree top adventure where you will have a chance to explore a rope bridge, a challenge course, and a zip line through the top of the forest.

Day 9 • Whitewater Rafting the Nahatlatch River - Rafting the Nahatlatch River is a sweet and intense ride and is a perfect day rafting trip. The steep-walled canyons create an adrenaline-filled ride with some of the most amazing scenery in all of Canada.



Day 10 • Watch the Salmon Run at Victoria Goldstream Provincial Park

During the spring and summer months Goldstream Park turns into a rainbow of colors because of the awakening blossoms from the forest's floor that erupt like the shade-loving western trillium. Goldstream takes pride in its annual salmon run that begins in June. Horseback riding through the park is an option as well.
